Biathle

Biathle is a continuous run / swim / run event organised outdoors with an open water (Sea) swim it is organised over the following distances:

Youths D & E	Run 500m	Swim 50m	Run 500m
Youths C	Run 500m	Swim 100m	Run 500m
Youths B	Run 1000m	Swim 200m	Run 1000m
Youths A, Junior & Senior	Run 1500m	Swim 200m	Run 1500m
Masters	Run 1000m	Swim 100m	Run 1000m

Transition Area:

A transition area will be provided inside the last 50 metres of the first run in which competitors remove their shoes. A pre-assigned box will be available in this area for each competitor's shoes, goggles etc. **Shoes must be worn for the run and will not be allowed in the swim.**

Competition Clothing:

All competitors must wear tops during the whole competition. Female competitors may wear one or two piece swimming costumes or Triathlon suits. Male competitors may also wear triathlon suits or tri tops with swimming trunks.

World Biathle Tour

This event is the part of the 2010 Biathle World Tour. The other events are in Dubai, South Africa, Germany, Egypt, Cuba and Italy. The best three results are to score for the overall championships. Medals will also be given to the first three finishers in each age group today.

World & European Championships

The 2010 European Biathle Championships are yet to be awarded. The World Biathle Championships will be held in Dubai on 30th October. The British team for the World's will be selected from the results of the British Biathle Championships at Salford.

GB Race Series

This event is also the part of the GB Biathle Race Series. Overall prizes will be awarded on completion of the series. Best three series results to count and a minimum of 2 races must be completed. In the case of a tie, the British Championships result will be the decider.
